

# PUBLIC NOTICE

Harrisburg R-VIII School District will be hosting a meeting at 1:00 p.m. on November 15, 2018 to discuss services available to private school children with disabilities. The meeting will be held at the Harrisburg R-VIII Administration Building. The following topics will be discussed during this consultation process:

- How parentally-placed private school children suspected of having a disability can participate equitably in special education and related services.
- How parents, teachers, and private school officials will be informed of the process.
- The determination of the proportionate amount of federal funds available to serve parentally-placed private school children with disabilities, including determination of how the amount was calculated.
- How the process will operate throughout the school year to ensure that parentally-placed private school children with disabilities identified through the child find process can participate in special education and related services.
- How, where, and by whom special education and related services will be provided for parentally-placed children with disabilities.
- How to conduct the annual count of the number of parentally-placed private school children with disabilities.
- How such services will be apportioned if funds are insufficient to serve all children and how and when these decisions will be made.
- If the local education agency disagrees with the views of the private school officials on the provision of services or types of services, how the local education agency shall provide a written explanation of reasons why the local education agency chose not to provide services directly or through a contract to the private school officials.
