

Parents & Students - This year, we are trying to limit the touching of paper and going to online with many items, including student registration, as you know. Each year, all students who participate in athletics/activities must turn in two documents in order to participate in any MSHSAA sponsored sport or activity in grades 7-12.

1. Extracurricular Handbook Acknowledgement - This is found online with your registration paperwork this year. If we find that we don't have your acknowledgement of reading through the handbook's policies & procedures, we will be contacting you to make sure it gets done. The handbook can be found on the school website under the athletics/activities tab.

2. Current Physical, Insurance, Concussion paperwork - Each year, every student athlete must turn this paperwork in, no matter if they have to get a new physical or not. Physicals are good for 2 years. If your 2-yr physical has expired or you have entered the 7th grade, the MSHSAA Pre-Participation Physical Form (5pgs) must be turned in (found on school website under the athletics/activities tab). This includes what you need to take to the doctor. If you have a physical that is CURRENT (1-Yr) and nothing has changed from the previous year (no ins changes, no new medical conditions), you need to turn in the new acknowledgment sheet for Physical, Insurance, Concussions, which we will be sending home with your student. If you have changes, please indicate this when the document is returned.
