

### **COVID Information for the 2020 Season (HS Gym)**

\*\*In order to play home games this year, the Health Department has laid out very strict guidelines that we must follow. Below are the guidelines that all fans must follow while attending a home game.

1. All players will be given 4 tickets for each of the first two home games. After that, a ticket list will be developed and kept at the gate. If you are on that list, you will be allowed to enter (no ticket required). If an additional member of your family needs a ticket, please check with Coach Fessler, Coach Fisher, Coach Richardson or the high school office.
2. Masks will be expected to be worn by all spectators while in the school.
3. There will be pods where families will be allowed to sit. Please sit in one of those pods and socially distance from other families. Families will not be assigned pods. There will be pods of either 2 or 4 people. Please sit in a pod that best fits your family. For example, if you have 6 people, sit in one of the 4 person pods and socially distance as much as possible from the nearest pod. Once you see how everything is marked on the bleachers, this will make a lot more sense.
4. For home games, all fans will be required to park in the north lot between the gym and football field OR in the gravel lot between the football and baseball fields.
5. All home fans will be required to enter through the north entrance (the one by the new locker rooms). Please do NOT enter through the main entrance.
6. All home fans will sit in the north bleachers on both sides of the court, and the middle sections on both sides of the court. The south bleachers on both sides of the court will be reserved for visiting fans. Signs will be posted.
7. Home fans will only be allowed to use the restrooms in the OLD locker rooms. The restrooms in the commons will be reserved for visiting fans. The concession area will remain the same for home fans. A visitor's concession stand will be provided in a separate location.
8. Please try to keep kids seated with you and supervised throughout the game. Try to limit traffic in the hallways as much as possible, as we are not allowed to cross paths with the visiting spectators at all.
9. Please know that games can, and likely will, change date/location on short notice. Please be flexible with these changes.
10. What about tickets/restrictions on away games?
  - a. We do not have any control on away games. We are at the mercy of the other school. There will be restrictions at every away game. What those are will vary each game.
11. Where can I find updates about games or practices?
  - a. Updates will be made on the school calendar after they happen. There is also a weekly Athletic/Activities Bulletin that comes out on Monday mornings through school messenger email and on Facebook.
  - b. Sign up with the Remind app through Coach Richardson or Coach Fisher

This will be a year of constant change. We will do our best to update you when we can. Please be flexible and understand we are doing the best we can. Practice times and locations WILL CHANGE. Game schedules, times, and locations WILL CHANGE. We will all just have to work together to get through it.
